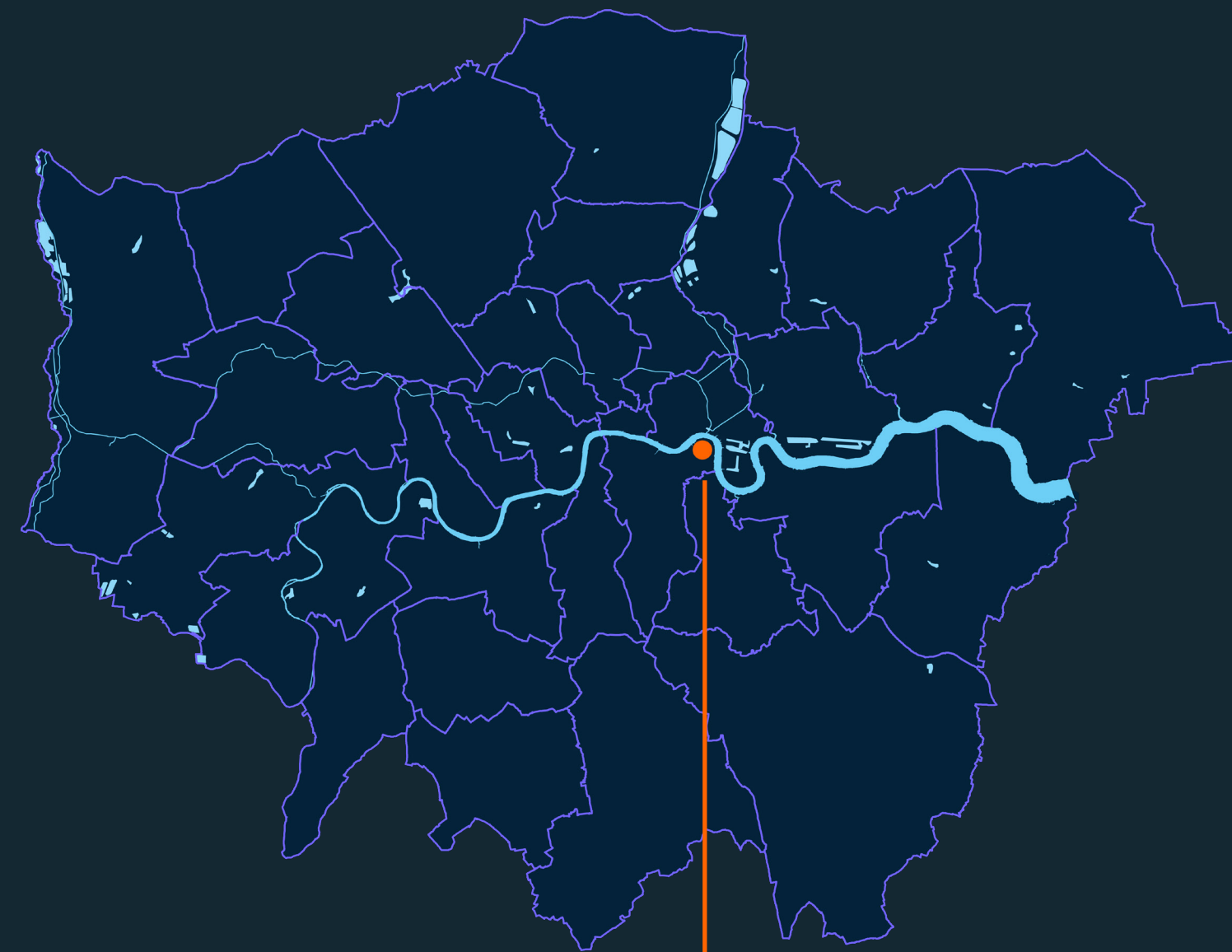


Agenda and Schedule

About eSC

eSC is a brand new category of sport with the championship's first races taking place in London in May 2022. It will be accessible to all and promote the use of sustainable micromobility transportation in urban areas.

Riders will race a specially designed eSkootr known as the S1-X. This eSkootr was developed by YCOM and Williams Advanced Engineering and can reach speeds of 100 km/h, on unique inner-city circuits.
